INFANT MILESTONES

MONTHS 6-12



GROSS MOTOR

- Sitting unsupported
- · Creeping/crawling on hands and knees
- Standing with support, pulling up on furniture
- · Walking sideways while holding onto furniture
- · Lowering to floor with control
- · Taking steps while hands are being held

FINE MOTOR

- · Using hand and fingers to pick up small objects
- · Banging two objects together at midline
- · Transferring objects from one hand to the other
- · Poking and pointing using index finger
- · Pulling, turning, poking, and tearing toys
- · Dropping objects into containers

COMMUNICATION

- Responding to name and simple words/phrases
- · Responding momentarily to inhibitory words
- · Babbling long strings of sounds
- Using simple gestures (waving, putting arms up, etc)
- · Engaging in simple games like peek-a-boo
- Saying 1-2 words (around 10-12 mos)
