GROSS MOTOR

- · Jumping in place with both feet
- · Climbing up and going down a toddler slide
- · Catching a large ball thrown from 2 feet away
- · Pedaling a tricycle
- · Standing briefly on one foot when one hand being held by an adult
- Walking backwards

FINE MOTOR

- Stacking six 1-inch blocks
- Holding crayons with thumb and fingers
- · Stringing large beads on a stiff string
- · Cutting with scissors
- Imitating/copying vertical and horizontal lines and circles

COMMUNICATION

- Using word combinations
- · Saying their name
- Using some plurals, action verbs, and past tense
- · Giving reasons for things and events
- Asking "why" and "how"; answering "what" questions
- Correctly producing most vowels, p, b, m, h, w, d, and n in words
