- Turning pages in a book one at a time
- Placing pegs in a pegboard
- Stringing larger-sized beads
- Building towers of four or more blocks
- Scribbling, trying to draw lines up, down, and across a page, as well as circles

COMMUNICATION

- Using and understanding at least 50 different words
- Putting two or more words together
- Following two-step directions
- Using words like me, mine, and you; using words to ask for help; using possessives
